



SAMUEL SOUTH & SONS

Tent Farm lay to the north of White Hart Lane about halfway between Tottenham High Road to the east (right) and the village of Wood Green to the west (left).

The farm overlaid a rich deposit of London clay and became the site of Samuel South & Sons and the neighbouring pottery of E G Cole & Sons.


The plans on the following pages, illustrate the development of the site and the South pottery.




Samuel South(1) moved his pottery from Dysons Lane, Edmonton, to White Hart Lane in 1886. At first, the site was leased but, later, the freehold was acquired and adjoining land was purchased for expansion and for future clay workings.


